## BYOD Program Information

At St Patrick's we utilise technology as a tool to aid our learning and develop critical thinkers who are able to access information and communicate effectively, thereby enhancing their potential as life-long learners.

From Year Four we ask that you supply your child with an iPad as part of our Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) program. We recommend an iPad with minimum 32GB as the children create and use multimedia that produces files that are quite large. It can be a full size or iPad Pro (we do not recommend a mini as the screen is too small). iPads must have **iOS10** installed on them; therefore, we ask that the device be an iPad 2 or above.

Your child must have the required apps installed on their iPad to ensure that they can fully participate in all teaching and learning activities. On the next page you will find a list of the required apps. Most of the apps are free, those with a cost have the price stated.
